

GALLERY FRAMES | *How to hang your frames*



1. SELECTING YOUR ITEMS

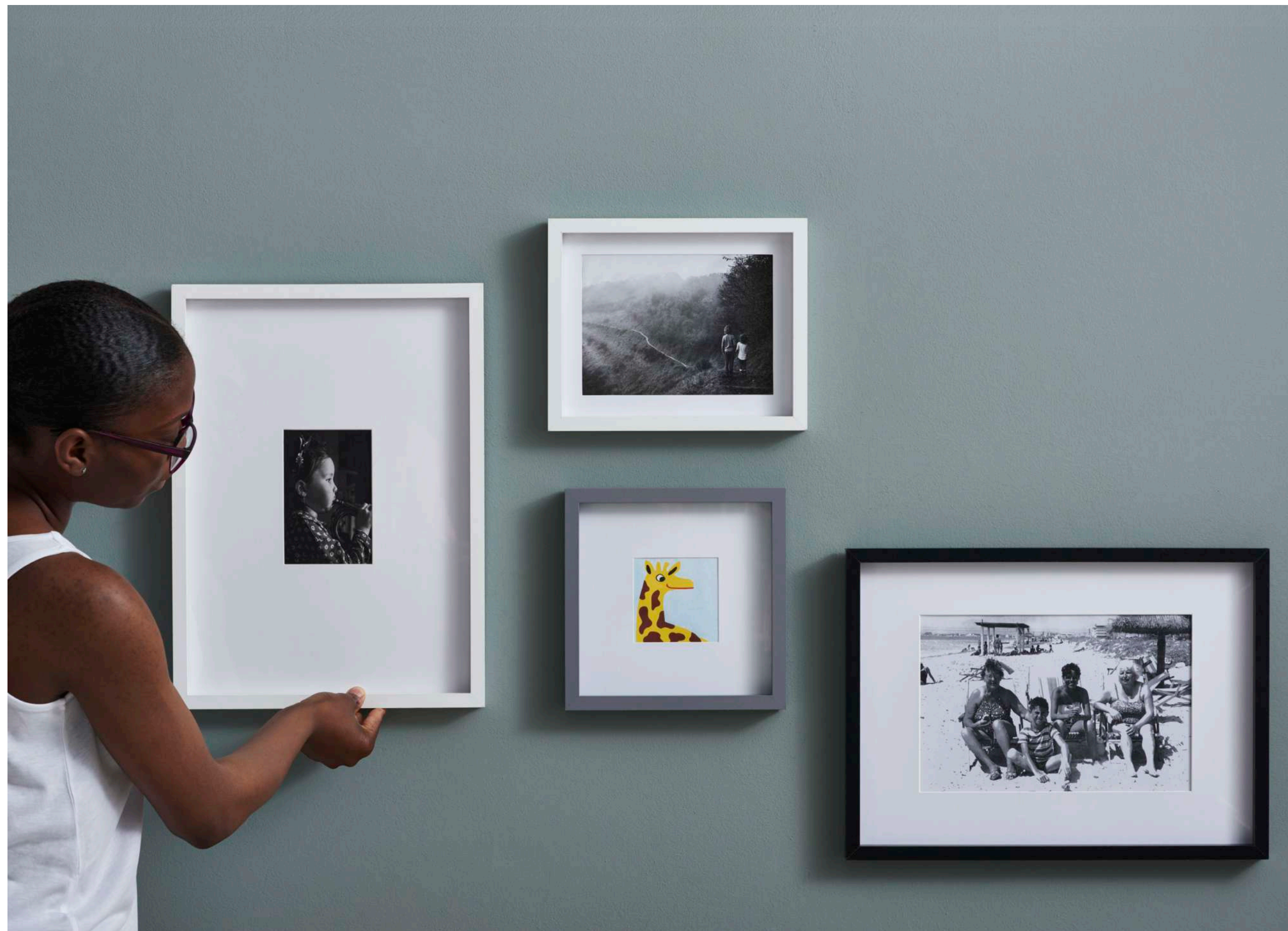
Almost anything can have visual impact when framed and hung. Collate and collect by mixing the gallery frames and fill with photos, fabric, postcards and found objects.

2. PLANNING YOUR LAYOUT

Mock up with paper, planning gives a perfect finish. Mock up on the wall the layout with pieces of paper using a tape measure for a neat even look.

3. HANGING YOUR FRAMES

Anchor your favourite image in the centre and work your way out. Get help from a friend and keep holding up the frames to check, measuring as you go.

4. FINAL CHECKS

Take a step back and ensure you are getting the desired effect. By constantly checking from a distance you will ensure the frames look good as the selection grows.

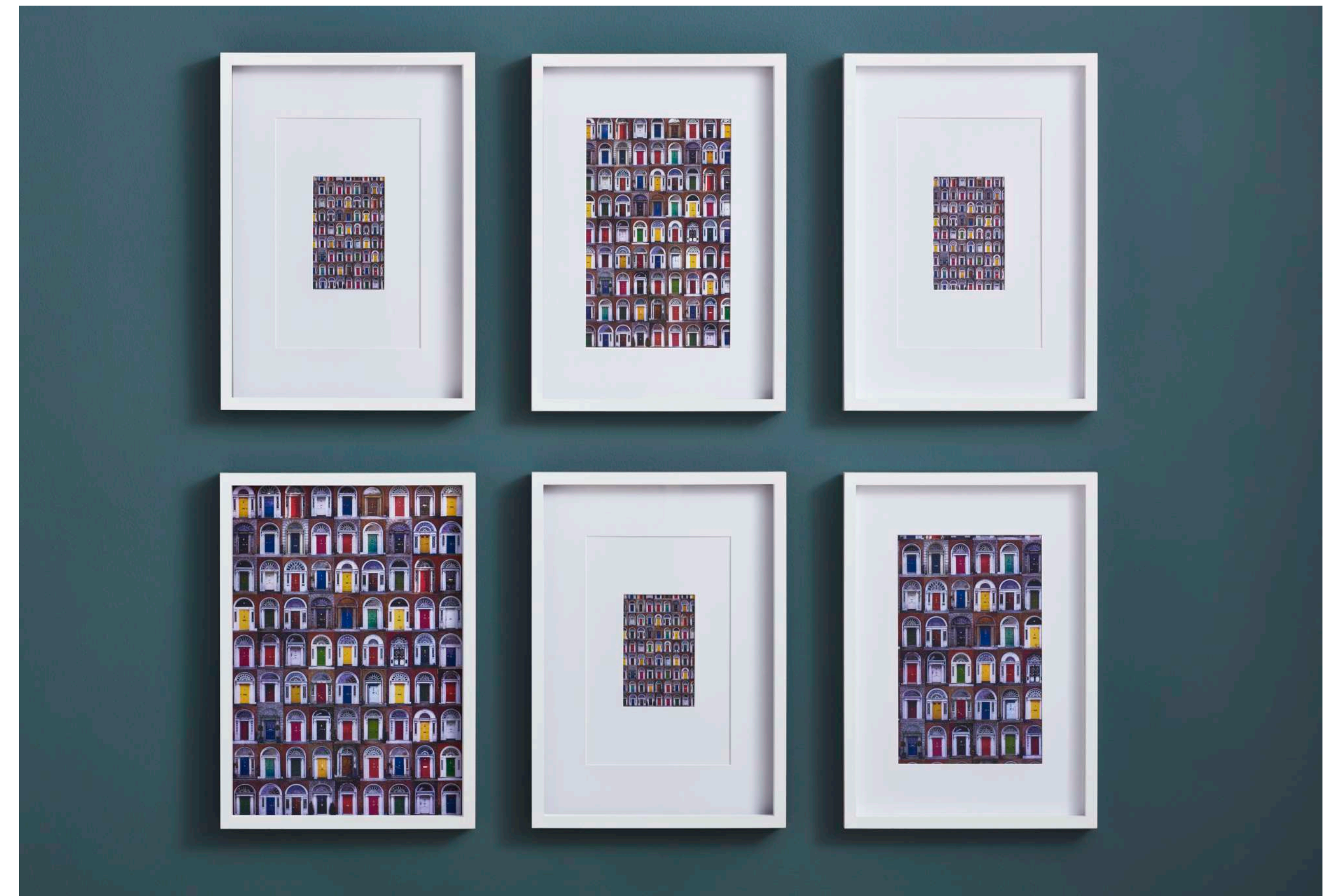

CENTRED

Set the theme with the central image and then the satellite frames can have objects and images that tell a story.



FORMAL LAYOUT

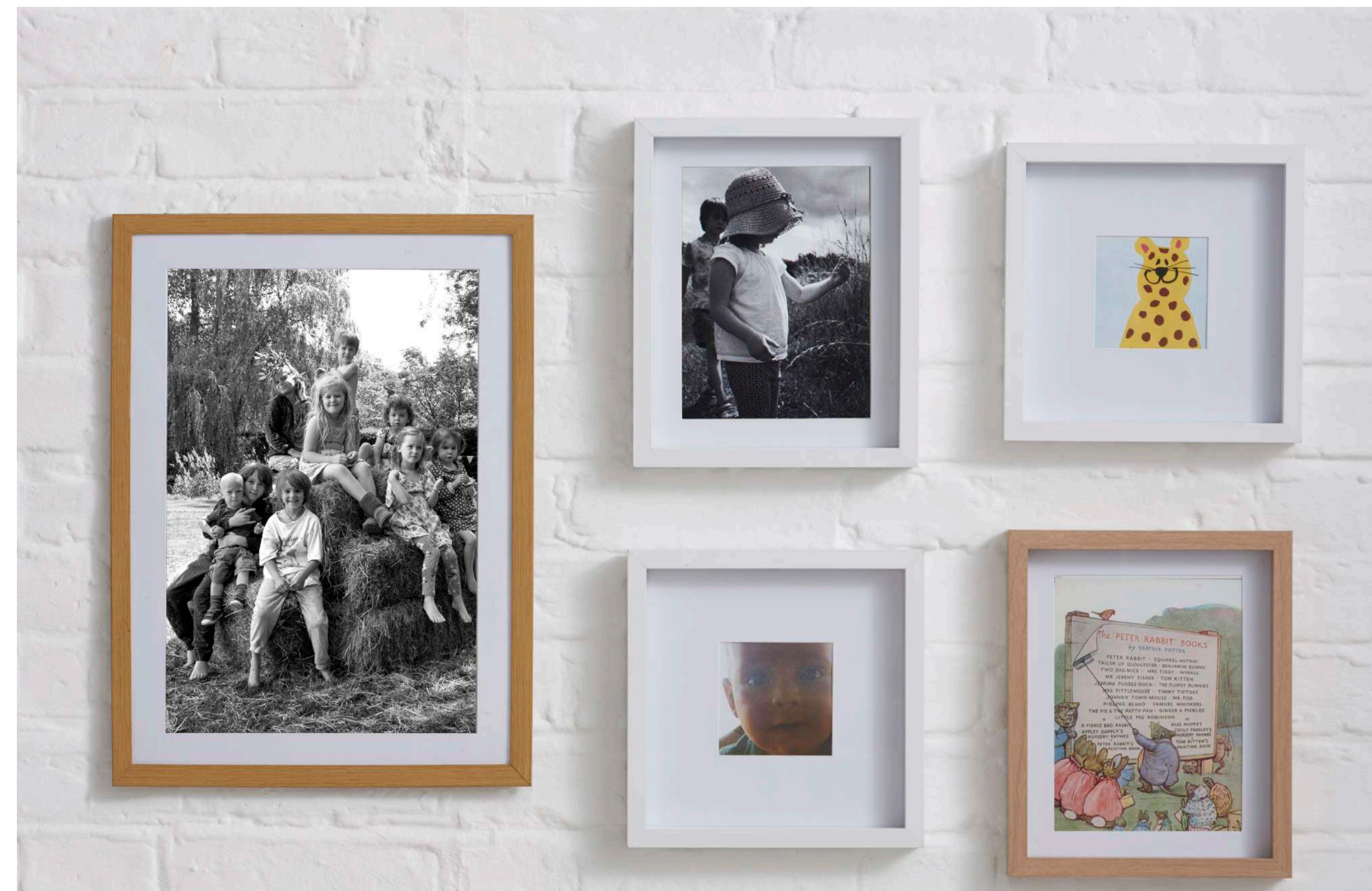
6 frames of the same size that can be shown over a sideboard or console. With our poster frames you are given a choice of mounts so you can ring the changes.
