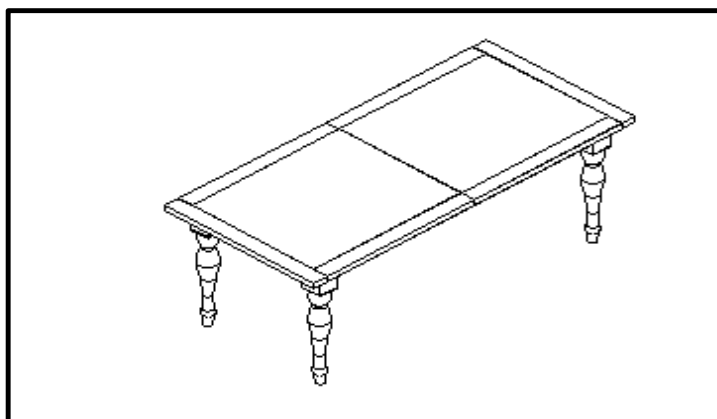
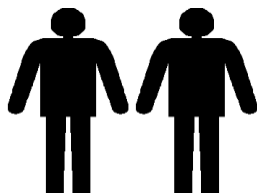


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS.

Regrettably self assembly items cannot be returned once assembly is part or fully completed unless the item is found to be faulty. Should you need to return the unassembled product, please repack in the original packaging.

IMPORTANT

- We suggest you spend a short time reading through this leaflet and then follow the simple step-by-step instructions.
- Carefully check that you have all parts before beginning assembly.
- Keep fittings out of children's reach and keep children well away from the construction area.
- We recommend that the packaging is used to protect the surfaces during assembly.
- A minimum of 2 persons is required to assemble this product.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

- Made from solid oak and oak veneer with oil finish.
- Made in Lithuania.
- Natural features ensure that each piece is individual. Every effort is made to ensure colour continuity between pieces, however this is a natural product, slight colour variations and natural grain markings may occur.
- Oak wood and veneers often have random pale markings in the grain, these are medullary rays which are a natural unique feature of the wood.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- For general cleaning, periodically dust with a soft cloth.
- Do not rub or scrub the surface when cleaning.
- Use a furniture oil periodically to maintain the finish and prevent the oil from drying out.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning products or those containing silicone.
- Any spills should be removed immediately with a soft clean damp cloth and dried immediately.
- Ensure the product is protected with mats and coasters when items are placed on the surfaces, to prevent scratching or damage.
- Do not put hot dishes directly on the surfaces of the item.
- Avoid keeping furniture in direct sunlight or close to any heat sources as this can cause cracking, discolouration or warping.
- Never drag pieces of furniture across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints.
- All assembly fixings should always be tightened properly and periodically check all fixings and tighten if necessary.
- We recommend that the extending dining table is left fully extended and uncovered for the first few months so that the natural mellowing process occurs evenly across the table top.

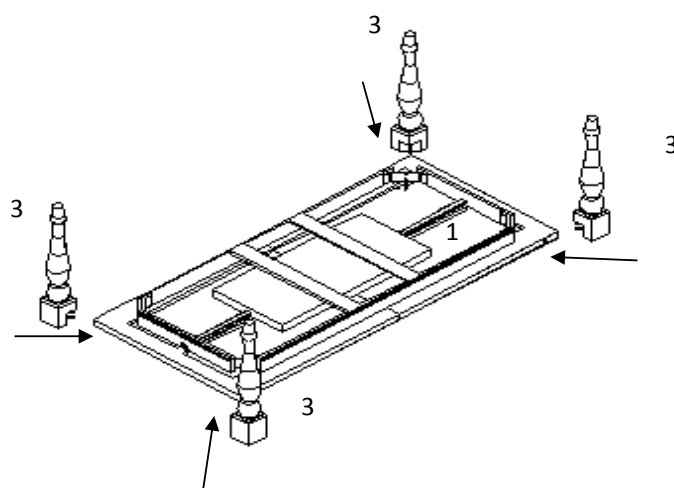
STEP ONE

Before assembly please remove the transit blocks x 4 from the corners of the table using a screwdriver (not supplied).



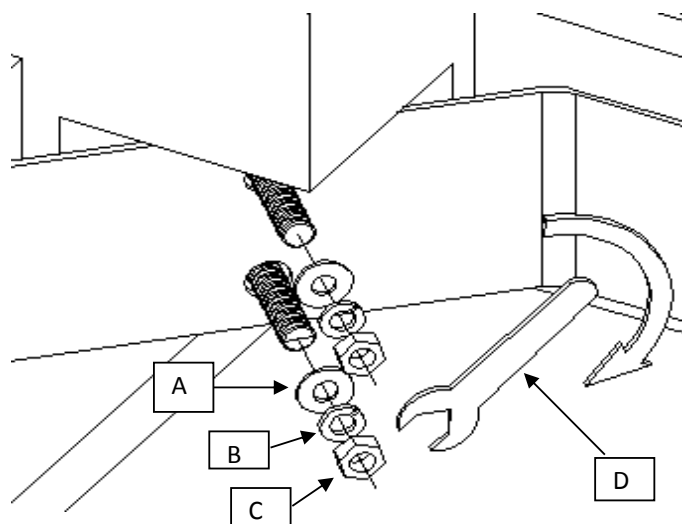
STEP TWO

Attach all the legs 3 to the corners of the table 1 ensuring the bolts locate through the metal brackets.



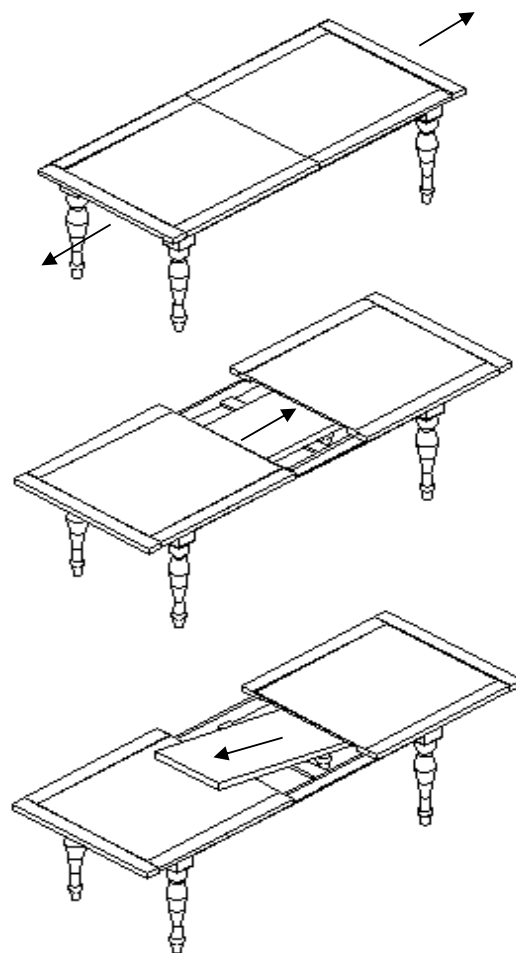
STEP THREE

Secure each leg to the tabletop 1 with 2 x flat washers (A), 2 x Spring washers (B) and 2 x nuts (C) using spanner (D) supplied.



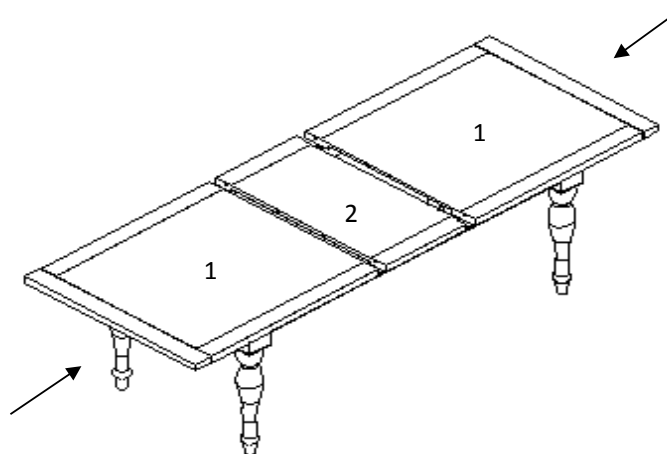
STEP FOUR

After assembling please unpack extension leaf of the table.



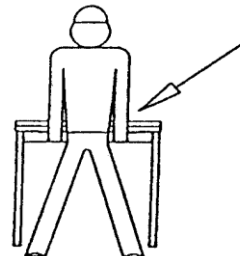
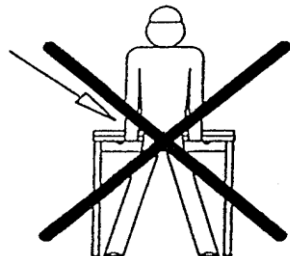
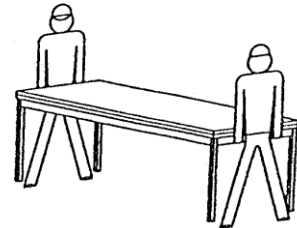
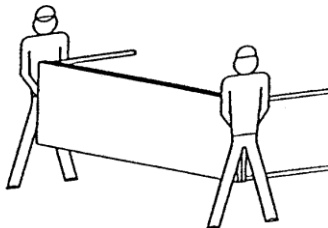
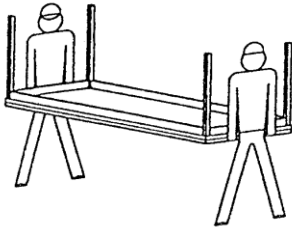
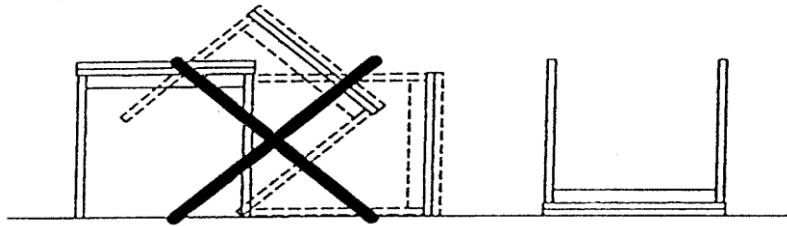
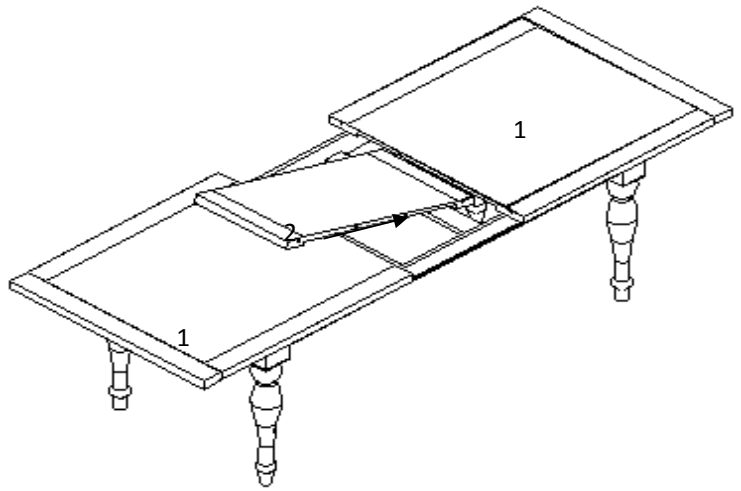
STEP FIVE

- 1.Insert extension leaf 2, between the open table top ends 1 and ensure the pins are the correct way round and line up with each other.
- 2.Close the ends of the table table top 1.



STEP SIX

1. The extension leaf 2 can be stored within the table as shown here or fitted in place as shown in STEP FIVE.



Do use two people to turn the Table.
Do not turn the table by pivoting it on its legs.
Do not lift the table by the legs.
